Car parking is available in the Abbey Fields carpark however this may get busy with the race and church using the carpark so please walk or cycle if located close to the event. Abbey End Car Park should be used if the closer car park is full.

Your race number should be worn on the front of your top attached with the safety pins provided. Please complete the emergency contact information on the reverse of the race number.

At the conclusion of the race runners will be able to collect a snack, water and their medal from the finish area.

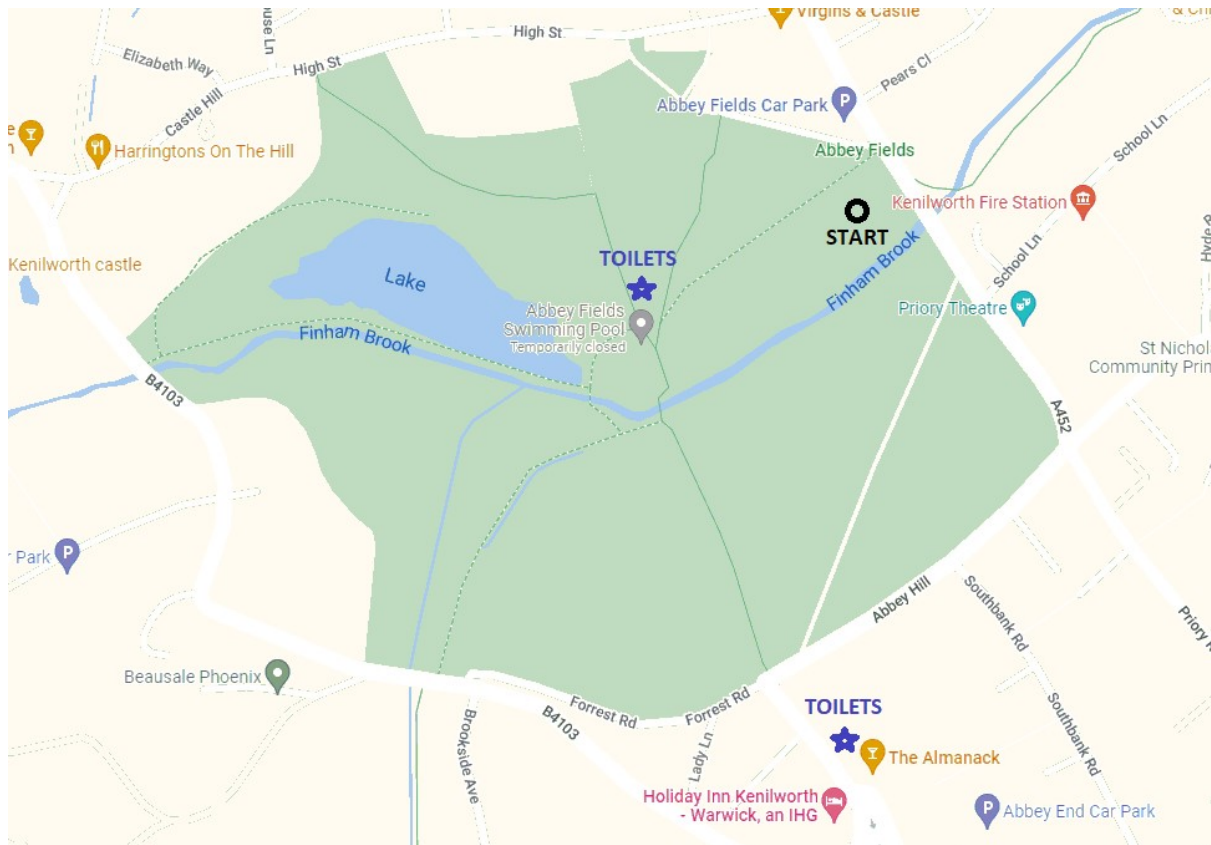
Race Rules:
